NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY HIRES FIVE UNDERGRADUATE INTERNS

The internship program was designed to recruit undergraduate interns interested in these areas, giving them early opportunities for career preparation. This year’s interns come from three chapters: California State University Monterey Bay, Eastern Kentucky University, and Saint Anselm College.
