EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S ADVISOR AWARDS ANNOUNCED

She has attended the National Leadership Conference and actively participated in many advisor webinars. Huffman has doubled the chapter membership numbers since she became advisor three years ago.

Hughes was recently elected as ALD's newest Professional Member-at-Large on the National Council. He started two new chapters of ALD in the last two years – one at California State University Monterey Bay and one at Sonoma State University.

Tammi Kohl Kennedy, Director of Academic Support at the University of Mount Union, in Alliance, Ohio, has been an ALD advisor since 2018. Kohl Kennedy has had exceptional recruitment for scholarships and switched her school from a manual invitation process to the online membership system.
